Unique Methods of Youth Work

We operate detached youth work sessions, where our Youth Workers go out into the streets. This unique method of youth work uses a number of tools including our very own *On/Off Road Quad Bike* and *Electric Bikes*. This allows workers to travel quickly around various areas.

We work closely with local partners and use our very own **Drone** to identify "**Hot Spot**" areas where we can target those young people who are involved in alcohol, drug or ASB issues.

We also provide a range of resources including our *Football Cage* to engage young people in positive activities. We will soon be launching our Home Office Supported Mentoring Programme which will support those young people at risk of entering the *Criminal Justice System*.
